

How to Map a Network Drive

1. Open Windows Explorer, select Tools>Map Network drive...



2. You should be presented with a window like below. Pick a free drive letter that does not have a drive mapped to it and the in the Folder box key in two backslashes, the IP for your IBM System, another backslash, and then DRV.
